Home Group book give away is going very well. Final report next month after the closing date—March 31, 2022.

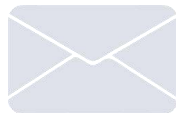

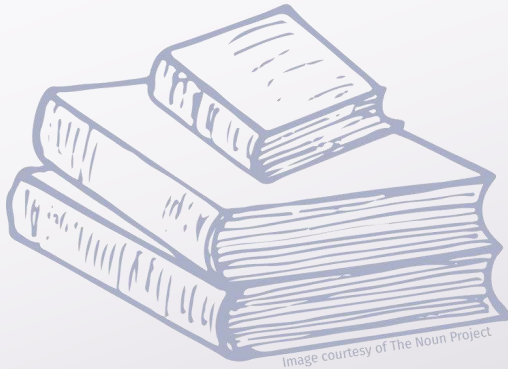

New to TVICO AA Store: Central Perk!

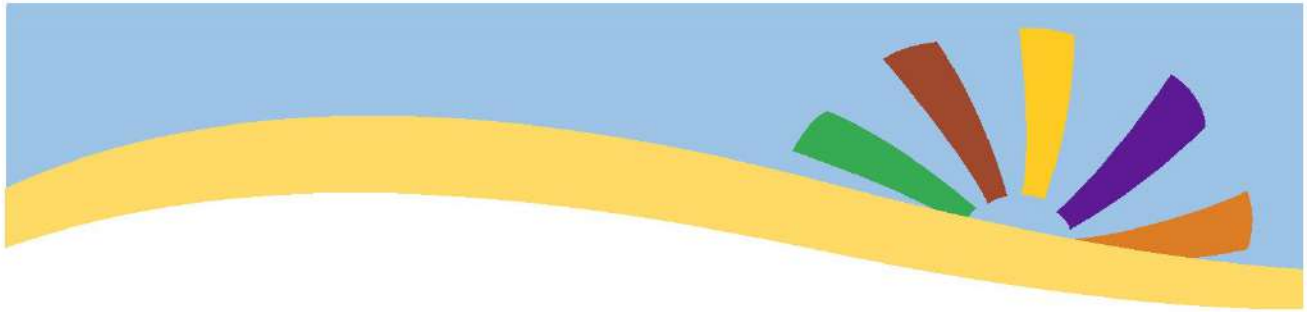

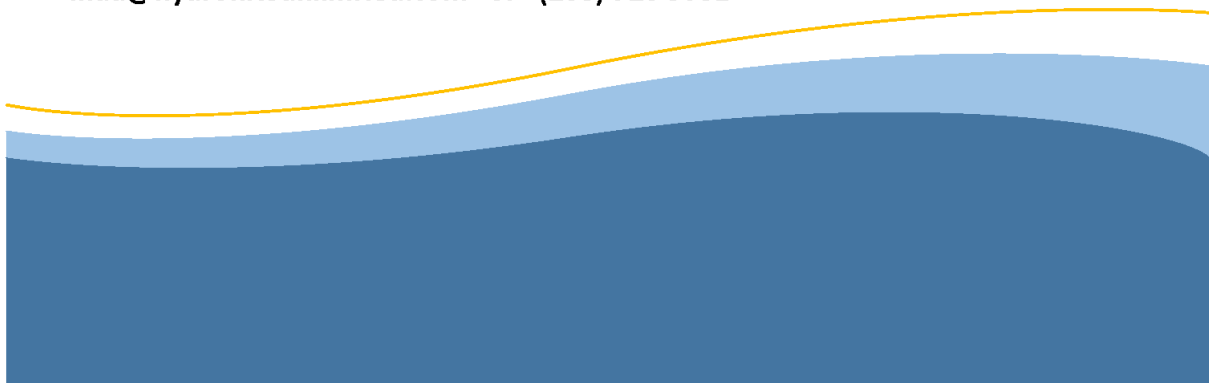

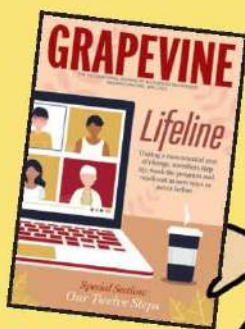
